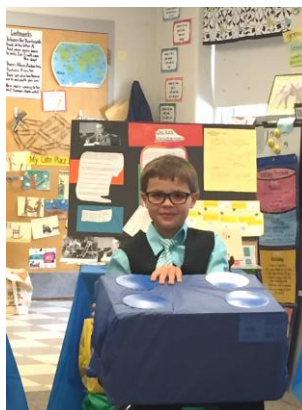

Live Wax Museum

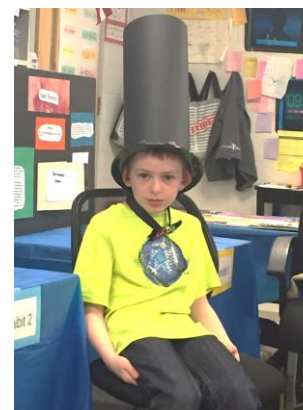
